这首大家耳熟能详的诗歌,竟然是作者在毫不知情之下,被發表出來,并且广为流传的 首诗歌。原來作者吉尔摩 Joseph H.Gilmore1834 — 1819 年是美国浸信会的 而他写此诗的时候,是在他二十五岁刚从神学院毕业之年轻时,有一次他负责带领查经 二十三篇之内容释义时,特別感受到主领我..方面,是多么奇妙的看 顾、爱护及保守,我们蒙受到祂的带领,是何等的有福啊! 因此他有感而发的丰富领受 也深深的影响感动了众弟兄姊妹,到了散会以后,他來到瓦森 Watson 执事家庭中,没 想到这位执事正和几个朋友仍在谈论着他刚才所分享的内容要旨,并且赞叹不已,此时 他们谈话的时候,吉尔摩当时突然有感而发,随即从口袋中拿出了笔,以及在刚才 写证道大纲所用的纸条上,马上整理写成了这首诗,回家以后便把它交给妻子,之后再 也沒有去想过这件事了,更別说期望它会为一首众所皆知的流传诗歌。 然而,他的太 馀,认为此作品实在丰富、咸人,于是便将它投寄到一个教会的报纸上,当作诗 來,没想到后來居然大为轰动,也翻译成许多版本,其中威廉 William B.Bradbury 为它所谱的曲,成为现今所流传的这首《祂带领我》。 三年之后,当吉尔摩來到罗徹斯特 Rochester 准备在该城讲道,并且擢升为牧师,正在礼拜中,他拿起了一本新编的诗歌本,当 领会者要求大家吟唱某首诗歌,打开一看,意外的看到他三年前所写的诗,我们现在不难想 像他的惊讶了!
